Preceptor Tax Incentive Program (PTIP)

PTIP allows community-based physicians to receive a tax credit for providing uncompensated training to our state's medical students.

Eligibility

- Licensed Georgia physicians, nurse practitioners or physician assistants
- Does not receive direct compensation for teaching medical, osteopathic, NP, or PA students from any source
- Rotations must support a Georgia medical, osteopathic, NP or PA program
- Must complete a minimum of one (160 hours) rotations to be eligible
